For the Second Semester, Fourth Year, students are advised to prepare to take the OJT (80hrs) in designated companies and a minimum of 40 hrs of seminars in finance and finance-related professional exams such as Certified Securities Representatives by Securities & Exchange Commission, Chartered Financial Analyst Level 1 Exam by CFA Institutes; Financial Management Aptitude Test; etc. Parents are advised to prepare for the financial requirements.

Under this program graduates are expected to be prepared to take entry level jobs in banks, investment banks, governments and private financial institutions and in microfinance research as well as become corporate finance analyst, capital market research analyst, securities analyst, financial manager and other types of finance professionals.
